“I enrolled in BOCES because I have wanted to become a hairstylist since I was a little girl,” said Brook.

Today’s cosmetologists change people’s lives and make them feel good about themselves. They have the opportunity to choose which work environment suits them best and use their creativity to the fullest.

Under the instruction of Deb Gampietro, Brook has learned about cutting, styling and coloring in a live clinic, which is open to the public.

“Brook is always ready to take on a challenge and learn new skills,” said Gampietro. “She competed in the cosmetology portion of SkillsUSA last year. She also completed shadowing of a salon to learn new techniques. She is a nominee for the National Technical Honor Society (NTHS).”

In the fall of 2024, following graduation, Brook plans on taking her state board exams and getting her license to work in a salon.

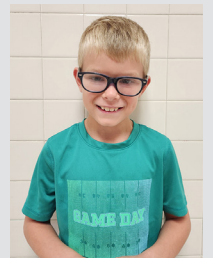
Depew Student’s Success Rises

“He is very caring toward other students, is working really hard, and does everything with great enthusiasm,” said Sean’s instructor, Elizabeth Harm.

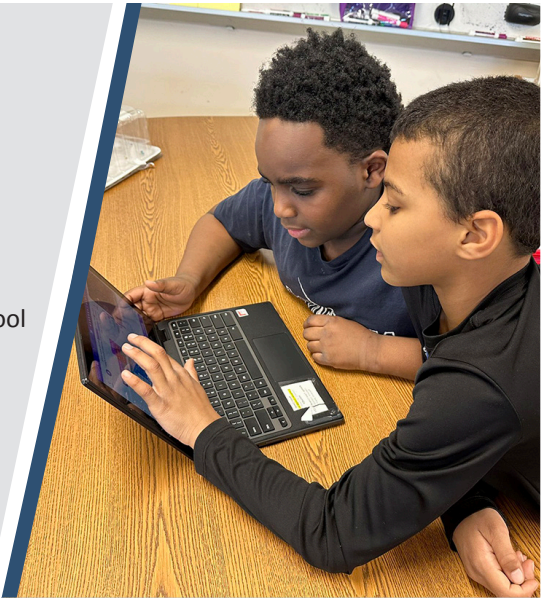
Upon graduation, Sean hopes to be a pilot and fly rocket ships.
