Re: Board Of Education Resolution

Jamestown City Schools has made a major commitment of integrating technology into the instructional process based on the guidelines of SED's Long Range Plan for Technology. To date the district has taken planning steps to accomplishing this goal.

Currently, the district would like to add additional network printers. A need also exists to make network printers more easily accessible to teachers and administrators. Jamestown participates in Common Set of Learning Objectives and Management Services.

Since Jamestown City Schools currently lacks funding to complete all aspects of this project during the 2018-2019 school year, the Board of Education is requested to authorize the entering of a five-year financial agreement (IPA) in an amount not to exceed \$747,705.

I am, therefore, requesting the favorable consideration and adoption of the following resolution at the June 13, 2018 Board of Education Meeting necessary to enter into this IPA:

MPN 084-02-19 (\$522,923 Instructional)

WHEREAS, The Board of Cooperative Educational Services, First Supervisory District, Erie County, New York ("Board") finds it necessary to install additional network printers under Common Set of Learning Objectives and Management Services to meet the needs of the school district, and

WHEREAS, the Board has evaluated and reviewed the project expansion which will function at Jamestown City Schools and will enhance the project currently supported by the Erie 1 BOCES, and

WHEREAS, the above referenced evaluation has produced a decision that the additional network printers meet all specifications, and

WHEREAS, the current outright purchase of the network printers is not possible within the current fiscal budget; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board authorizes the administration to enter into a Financial Agreement (IPA) for a five-year term for the additional network printers in an amount not to exceed \$747,705.
