



Why Choose 2-Color Presswork from Erie 1 BOCES?

A \$.055 color 11x17 click + lease/purchase expense.

4 hours to process (10 front/back prints a minute)

for a person making about \$35,000 a year w/benefits.

Half-fold ability is based on the machine capability within the district.

For a district to fold would be an added cost

to your district in time and/or personnel.

Does not include electricity or other space-related expenses.

Understanding BOCES Aid

Printing services at Erie 1 BOCES are eligible for BOCES Aid. The aid formula for Erie 1 BOCES' component districts ranges from 62 to 82 percent. Printing supplies, which were likely purchased at a volume discount, are non-aidable so that must be deducted (est. 12%).

Meaning a \$1,000 order could prompt \$545-\$721 back to a school district based on their current year BOCES state aid ratio.

In the case of Common Core materials, Text Book Aid can be used instead of BOCES Aid. A public school district cannot use Text Book Aid and BOCES Aid at the same time. It is one or the other.

Attaining aid is process between a school district and the state in the following school year.
