

How to register a non WNYRIC.ORG DNS name

1. You will need to register a DNS name with a company that can register domain names. To see if the domain you wish to use is in use, you can use the following web site:

2. Once you have registered and purchased your DNS name (which could take up to 72 hours or more), you will need to add the following information to your WHOIS (Domain Name) information

A. Administrative contact. You can use yourself or Robert Giannicchi (See below). This will be your choice.

B. Technical contact. We suggest using the following:

C. You will need to add the following Domain name servers in the Domain name server listings:

NS3.WNYRIC.ORG 168.169.8.21 *

NS4.WNYRIC.ORG 168.169.8.22

* This domain name server has to be listed as PRIMARY. All others can be listed as secondary.

3. We (Erie 1 BOCES) will then verify this information. This could take up to 72 hours or more.

4. When all information is verified, you will need to fill out a DNS form to add your Domain name in our ERIE 1 BOCES domain servers. This can be found here:
