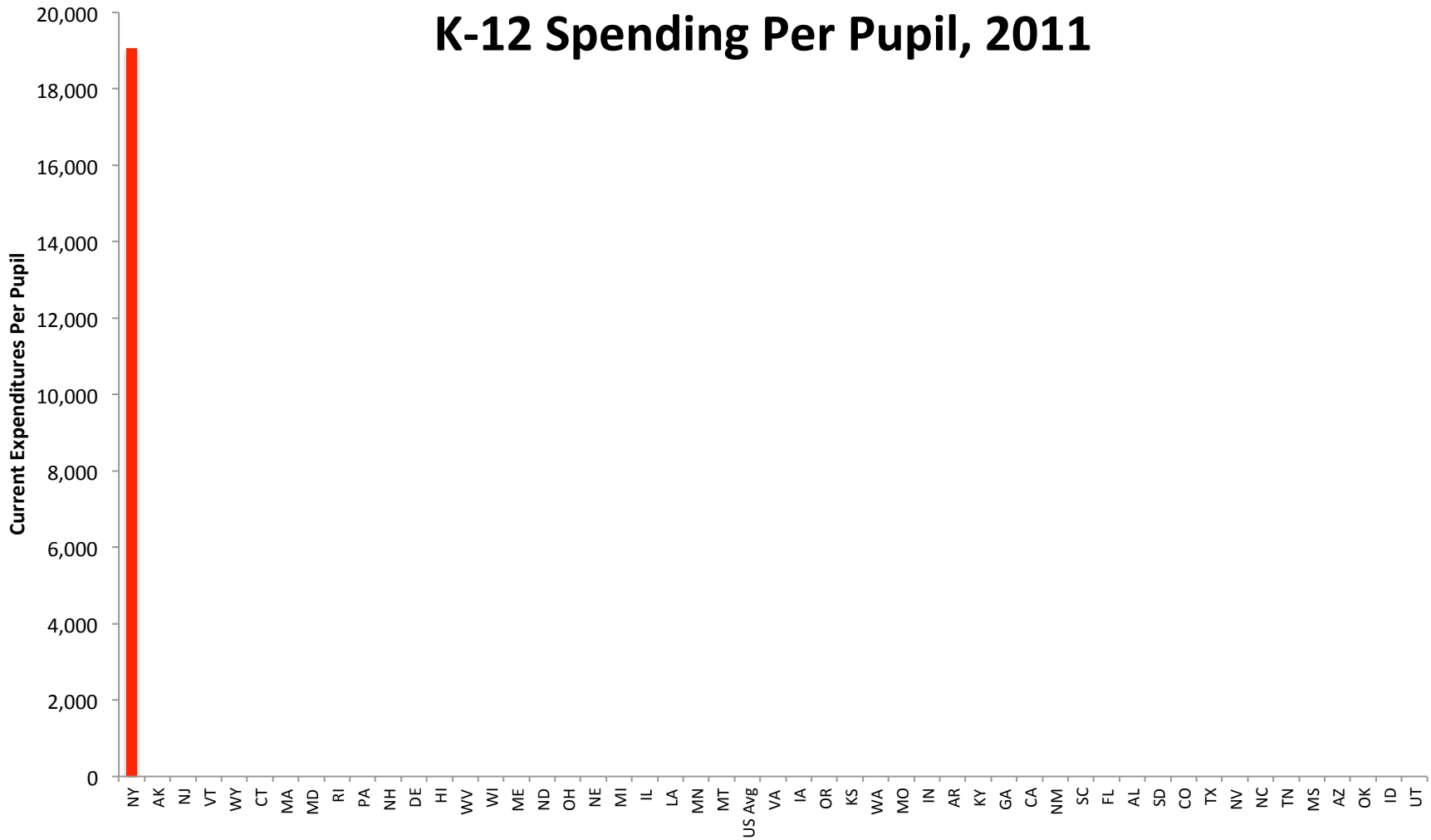

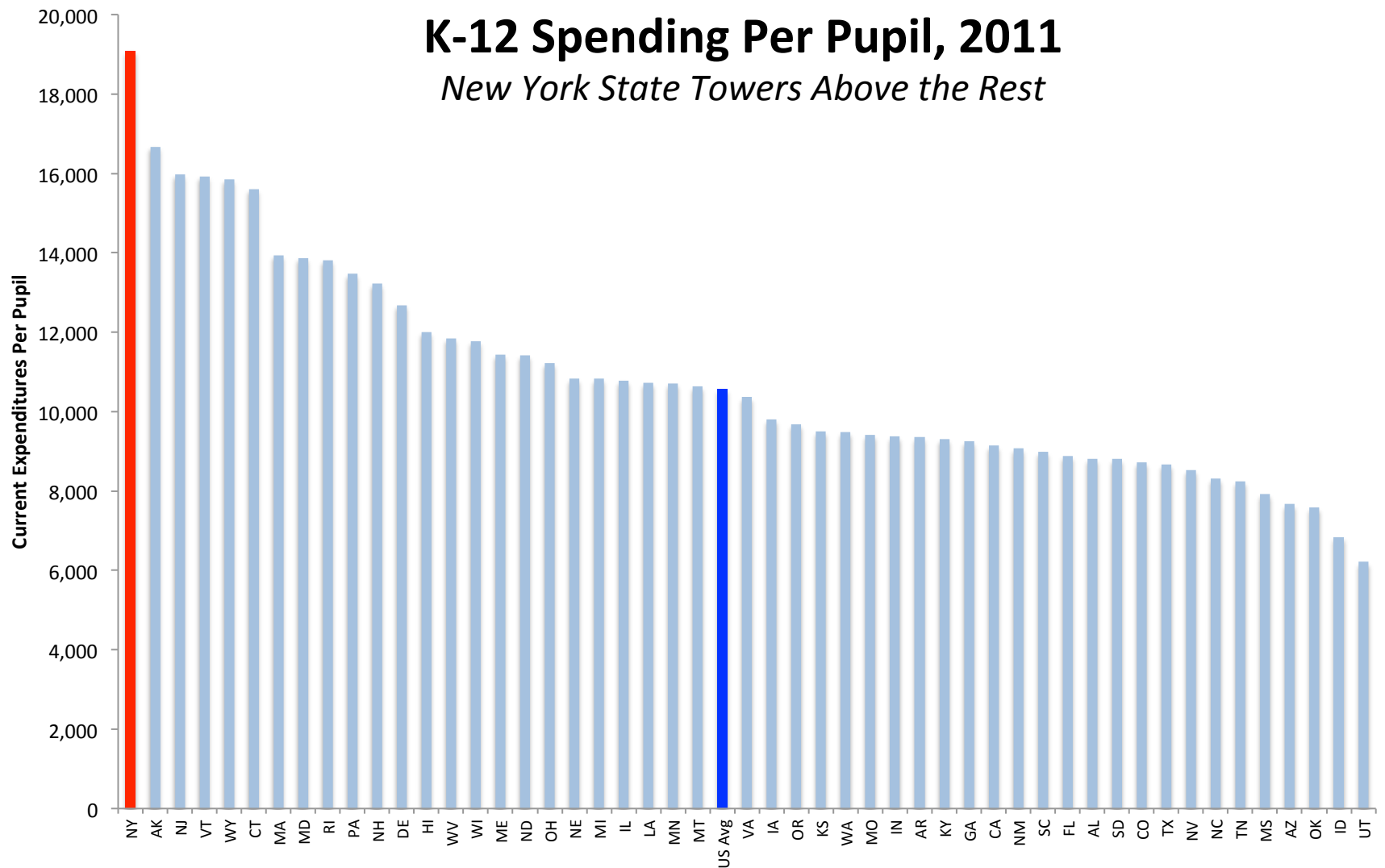
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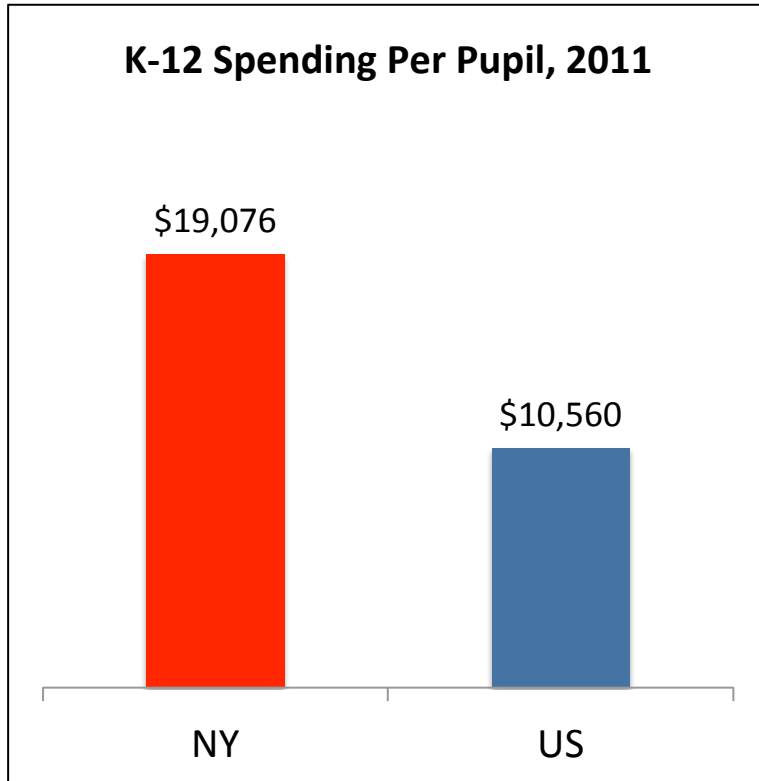
K-12 Spending Per Pupil, 2011

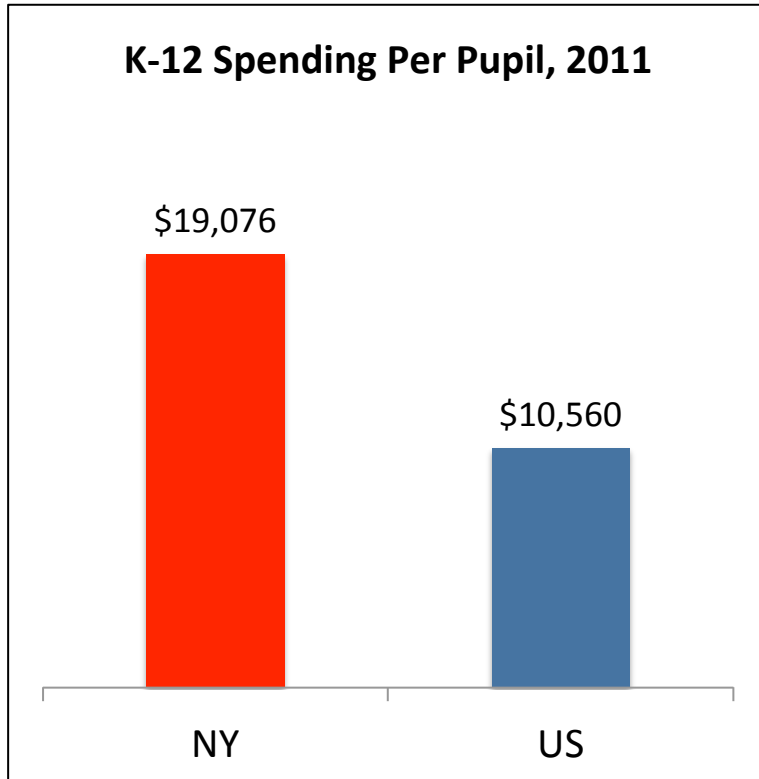

New York State Towers Above the Rest



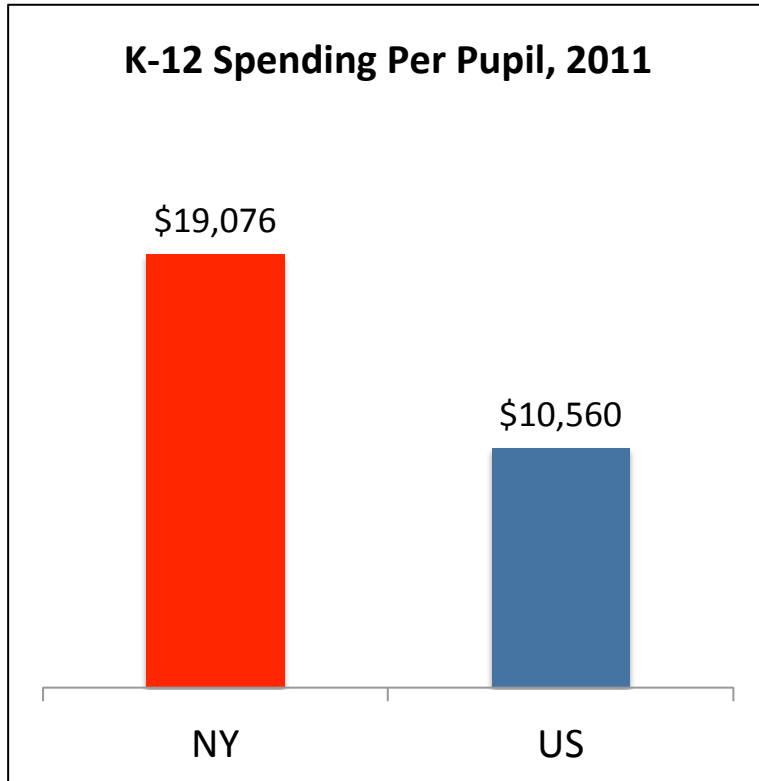
