Instructor Jason Bieger said Declan has been "an outstanding student who consistently has over 100 percent average." Declan is known for accepting every opportunity that comes his way and has been recognized in the community for his work.

Notably, Declan won his category in the 2024 Buffalo News Editorial Cartoon Contest and placed third in a design contest for a suicide prevention campaign through Brylin Hospital. Bieger describes Declan as a "perennial overachiever with the kindest personality."

Declan said his passion for photography and graphic design led him to join this program.

"I chose this CTE program because I wanted to hone my skills in an area I love," he said. Balancing a rigorous Advance Placement course load at his home school, Declan sought a creative outlet that would allow him to enjoy his studies while meeting new people.
