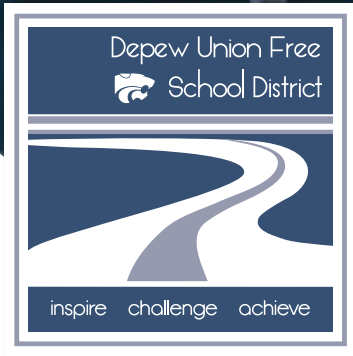

Depew is dedicated to supporting the whole child through its participation in the Community Schools CoSer. This initiative provides professional development, mental health support, and wellness resources to district staff through partnerships with other districts, agencies, and Erie 1 BOCES. As part of the CoSer, Depew staff participated in Trauma, Illness, Grief (TIG) Training alongside 41 colleagues from the region. This five-day course equips educators and support staff to respond effectively to the emotional needs of students affected by trauma, illness, and grief. By training staff to offer tailored support during crises, the program helps build trust within the school community, ensuring every student feels safe, respected, and understood.
