
The District Budget

The district has a more than \$1.1B annual budget. There are two major funding sources that support school operations: The General Fund, which is the primary fund of the district and supports the general day to day operations of the district. Eighty percent (80%) of the revenues come in the form of state aid. The Special Projects Fund, includes several grants from state, federal and local sources that are intended to be supplemental in nature and are provided for specific types of expenditures.

Board of Education

The nine-member Board of Education governs the Buffalo City Schools. Members of the Board are elected to serve three or five-year terms of office. The Board of Education meetings are held once a month with two work sessions per month. Board members are:
