#### Reading

### <u>Writing</u>

We will introduce grammar, usage, and punctuation, sentences and fragments, and basic sentence construction. Copywork will also be done to strengthen the skill.

## Spellings

Phonics mastery, decoding, vocabulary, comprehension, fluency, and spelling. We will also practice using reading and writing activities to strengthen the skill.

## Arithmetic :

#### 100 hours per year

Topics will include counting, addition, subtraction, numbers, fractions, measurements, time, plane and solid geometry, pre-algebra, data, etc. We will also use hands-on math games to reinforce concepts.
